Glass Block— Kid's Handprint

Supplies

5.5" Glass Block
Acrylic Paint
Golden Acrylic Medium—
GAC 200
18 Gauge Floral Wire
Floral Foam
Hot Glue Gun
Filler—Your Choice

Optional Supplies

Ribbon
Scrapbook Embellishments
Scrapbook Paper
20ct. White Lights
Onion Grass

Directions

1. Choose your favorite color of acrylic paint. Mix your paint with GAC 200 at a 1 to 1 ratio. Adding GAC 200 will increase the adhesion of the acrylic paint to the glass.
2. Spread paint out on an even surface, such as a paper plate. Have the child dip their hand in the paint so that the hand is covered in a thin layer of paint. Stamp hand on glass. Immediately wash the child's hand with soap and water. Allow the paint on the glass to dry for 24 hours.
3. Using needle nose pliers, twist an 8" piece of floral wire to form a swirl at the end of the wire. This will be your photo holder.
4. Once the block is dry, Cut a 2"x 1" x1.5" slice of floral foam and hot glue it to the bottom center of the inside of the block. Insert the wire photo holder into the foam.
5. Now fill the block using your choice of filler. There are many options of filler including sand, rocks, glass gems, water beads, flower petals, crayons, toys, etc. If you would like to...add lights at this time as well.
6. Finish off your block by adding ribbon or other decorations on the outside of the block .
