

# Supplies for Scrap Quilts: Easy, Breezy American Flag Stars, Stripes and More with Diane Harris 

Sewing machine in good working order AND THE MANUAL please (.)
Rotary cutting supplies (the classroom has mats for our use)
Neutral colored thread for piecing Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, mechanical pencil, small ruler, etc.

Fabric: Blues in lights, mediums and darks, light neutrals such as white or cream and reds including pink reds, salmon red, faded red and regular red of all sorts.

Amounts: Start with 1 yard total of reds and 1 yard total of light neutrals. Start with $1 / 2$ yard total of blues. I will bring fabric to share.

Cutting: Blues and neutrals will be cut into $21 / 2$ " squares for the stars. Reds and neutrals will be cut into $21 / 21 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for the stripes.

PLEASE NOTE: There's a lot of flexibility as to the size of your patriotic quilt. It's best to wait and see how you like the techniques and then settle on a size.


If you have a stash, bring a variety of reds, blues and light neutrals. Precut if you like according to page 1. I'll help you create a scrappy patriotic quilt.

If you do not have a stash, bring a couple of fat quarters each of reds, blues and light neutrals. I will help you by sharing my fabrics and shopping with you as needed.
